




PROJECT SUMMARY

Air Energy TCI (AET) has been progressing with the development of the proposed Crawford Wind Farm project near Bucyrus, OH (see map).

The proposal is for between 38- 64 wind turbines, generating up to 97 MW of renewable energy - enough to power around 25,000 homes - that will be fed into the Ohio state grid. The project will have a life expectancy of 25 years.

Environmental studies, which are required by the Ohio Power Siting Board as part of the permitting program, are already underway and include ecology, natural habitats, noise, archaeology, visual impact and aviation. These and other assessments are scheduled to continue until mid-2012, to complete the assessment process, while construction is currently planned for completion in December 2014.
